On why she has chosen to teach:

"I teach because I believe that our youths can be so much more than what they believe. I once had a teacher who believed in me, even when I had given up on myself. His contribution transformed my life. Experiences like that have convinced me that teaching is a noble pursuit that has real, lasting impact on the lives of youths. I teach to enable youths to pursue possibilities in their lives that allow them to become leaders in their respective fields."

On what she hopes to help students see about Singapore:

"We see buildings, a concrete jungle - but what we don't see is heart and courage. The audacity to dream beyond what the world could have imagined, and to chase after that seemingly elusive rainbow. It is a reminder that as long as we dare envision it, it is possible. I hope to help my students see that Singapore is a city of miracles, a country of possibilities, a nation of hope."

On making learning and life meaningful for her students:

"Student life for many has become about racking up points and achievements. I believe every single person is gifted. Digits and letters alone do not tell us our worth. I want to show each student that they are more than a result or a label. I hope to help my students have the courage to show their real selves, live out their purpose and start changing the world they live in."
